March 21st is Rock Your Socks Day!

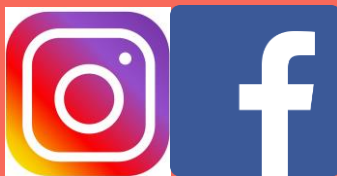
We are celebrating it on Monday the 22nd
