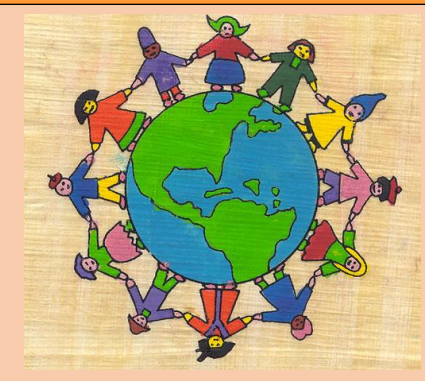
Congratulations to our staff of the month, **LWRA**. Thank you for your hard work and for bringing your energetic attitude to your classroom. Keep up the good work!
