Since the days are getting colder (and full of snow), it might feel better to stay warm inside. But how do we keep busy without being able to explore the outdoors??

Here's a recipe for Sensory Snow that will keep your little one busy and learning:

- Add 2 cups of baking soda or corn starch to a bowl
- Add ½ cup of conditioner to the bowl and mix

Feel free to play around with the ingredients until you get the right consistency- you should be able to pick it up and mold it into a snowball!

You can expand the play by adding toy animals, cars, people, or loose parts! Add food coloring or glitter for a different sensory experience! Get messy and have fun!
