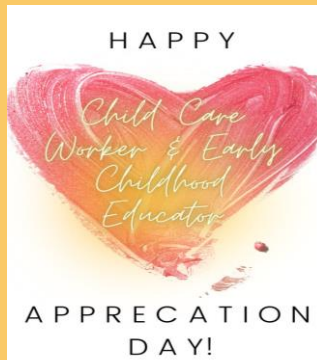
Just a reminder that
