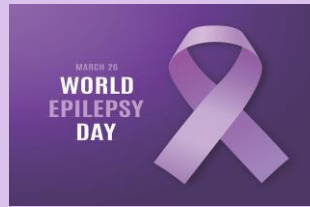
Staff of the Month
